



Valley Secretary's Message

Greetings Brethren,

I have found that over the year the most frequent issues we address are questions regarding Dues and Membership. If you have a Membership question, please call the Secretary for help and explanation. These are handled on a case-by-case basis. For Dues questions please do the same. Here are some general Dues concerns:

1). I did not receive my Dues Notice.

- A). Dues Notices are sent from Supreme Council in Lexington, MA **BY EMAIL in August**, The Scottish Rite Dues Cycle is from August 1st to July 31st of each year. This year's Dues are \$99.00 for 08/01/2025 to 7/31/2026 and are called 2026 Dues since it is in 2026, this Dues Year is finished and the 08/01/2026 to 07/31/2027 Dues year begins (2027 Dues).
 - B). Dues Notices are sent from Supreme Council in Lexington, MA BY MAIL in October.
- C). Late Dues Notices are sent from Supreme Council in Lexington, MA **BY EMAIL and MAIL in February**.
- D). Dues, when **paid from a Dues Notice** go to Supreme Council for processing, they in turn send the Valley of New Castle our funds on a Monthly Basis along with a Full Report explaining ALL Transactions.
- E). You can always send the Valley of New Castle a check for your dues to Valley of New Castle, 110 E. Lincoln Avenue, New Castle, PA 16101-2472. We can also take your Dues Payment by Credit Card, in person or over the telephone.
- F). Lastly, you can pay your dues through the **Member Center Portal** if you have set that up. This Portal gives you the ability to view and **update your Membership Information yourself**. You can Pay Dues, find out how may Degrees you have listed, change your address, telephone number, email address, birthday and anniversary date, and family information.
- G). The most important thing you can do is **keep your Address**, **Telephone Numbers and Email Address up to date**. If you move, how are we supposed to know and if we cannot get ahold of you, communication breaks down.

We are here to help you with whatever we can to make your **Scottish Rite Membership** as valuable to you as it can be, but **you have to take the initiatives to help yourself**. We have information sheets we can send to you explaining how to **setup your Membership Center Account**, and we are here to help you through the process.
