


A Hardy Hello Brothers,

#### **VALLEY ACTIVITIES**

Since the maximum number of people to have, in an inside group is 25, we have had to CANCEL most activities for 2020. There will be <u>No Ambassador's Brunch</u>, <u>No Oktoberfest</u>, and <u>No Christmas Party</u>.

We will try to start 2021 out with the <u>January 16, 2021 Pancake & Sausage Dinner</u> and the <u>January 20, 2021 Stated Meeting</u>, if we are able to meet at that time. We will continue to schedule things in advance and see if we must cancel them due to State Orders. We had many events scheduled for 2020, but one by one they were all cancelled due to no choice of our own. This has been a crazy time to operate a Scottish Rite Valley, but we will persevere like everyone else and see what the future holds for us all.

We will be doing a hybrid type of meeting with our new candidates in October, but it will <u>not be open to the full membership</u>, due to the pandemic. We will be contacting the candidates and letting them know of our plans very soon. If you have anyone who would like to join the Valley of New Castle, please have them call the Valley Office to talk to the Secretary to get informed of the proper procedure to become a candidate. You cannot plan anything too far in advance due to the possibility of cancellation anyway.

The Supreme Council of the Northern Jurisdiction will be hosting three Virtual Reunions this fall for all the members to view online if they chose to do so. You need to sign up for these viewings on the Supreme Council website or go to <a href="https://www.reunion.srnmj.org">www.reunion.srnmj.org</a> to get signed up for these Virtual Reunion Dates. They will be as follows:

October 24, 2020 - 9:00 AM - 04°, 17°, 19°, 26° - Subject to change without prior notice.

November 14, 2020 - 9:00 AM - 04°, 12°, 29°, 31° - Subject to change without prior notice.

#### **DUES & DUES PAYMENTS**

Brethren, I would like to take this opportunity to try to explain the <u>Dues Naming and Collection Procedure</u> for the Valley of New Castle. The reason for this is twofold, first, this is the most misunderstood thing that happens in the Valley, and it affects every member. Secondly, the Dues Collection Process has changed dramatically this year, due to the Covid-19 Pandemic.

The Dues Notices, in the past, were always sent out around April 01 of the year. The reason being, the Valley of New Castle's fiscal year, is from April 01, 2020 - March 31, 2021. Since Valley's have different fiscal years across the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction, it meant Supreme Council was always processing somebody's Valley Dues. This year when the Pandemic hit our Dues Notices were in the processing stage at Supreme Council. We were contacted initially and told that ALL Dues Collections would be halted until after June 01, 2020, to see what was going to happen to the membership from the Covid-19 Pandemic. During this time, Supreme Council decided that they were going to change the Dues Collection procedures completely. The New Process for Dues Collection is as follows. All Valley's in the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction are now going to be collected on or around August 01. This meant a four month change to our Dues Collection Procedure. This changes does not change our Dues Year, just the Collection Date. This brings us to the next area of confusion. Our Dues Year is from April 01, 2020 until March 31, 2021 and is called 2021 Dues. This is because it expires on March 31, 2021. Our next Dues period is from April 01, 2021 to March 31, 2022 and will be called 2022 Dues and will be billed for around August 01, 2021. This can be confusing, and we get more calls about this than any other thing. Just know, that you are only paying for one year at a time, and are always getting your years' worth of time. No one is trying to pull a fast one on you or cheat you out of your money, this is a Masonic Organization, and we still always do the best that we can for our Fraternity.



Just a friendly reminder, the Scottish Rite does not sent out yearly membership cards. The silver/gray plastic card that you currently have is a permanent membership card. If you do not have one, please contact the Valley Office and we will order you a new one. Also, for 50-year and over members, the Scottish Rite does not reduce you dues to zero. The policy is that anyone who is 80-years old or older AND who is experiencing financial hardship or a health-related issue that makes paying your dues a burden, may apply for Senior Status which will reduce your dues to zero. This needs to be done while you owe NO DUES, senior status requires a \$0.00 balance to be applied for. If you need to apply and OWE DUES, please call the Office for assistance.

#### THOUGHTS ON THE ORGANIZATION

The Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite of the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction of the United States of America is the Premier Masonic Organization in the World. It is made up of Four Bodies and they are as follows: the Lodge of Perfection, the Council of Prices of Jerusalem, the Chapter of Rose Croix, and the Consistory - the Sublime Princes of the Royal Secret. With the creation of the new Path Forward Initiative, from the Supreme Council, NMJ, and it was given to the Masonic Grand Lodges across the World, the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction, the Southern Jurisdiction, the Shriners International, and Grand Lodges across the World are working together to rebuild the Masonic Community. This does, however, come with some changes, and all those changes do not happen without a few mistakes. There will be some printing errors, there will be some Degree Presentation errors, there will be some things that are misunderstood. This must be expected when taking on such overwhelming change. The website Degree Presentation crashed the internet the first couple times, due to such great response. A new software was acquired, and it has been getting better, but there are still some glitches. I assure you they will be fixed. The new team that has been assembled at Supreme Council, NMJ, is young, eager, willing, and able to carry the Organization into the future. With some patience on the part of the membership and some assistance from the people that they replaced; the Organization has a Great Future. The numbers did not drop overnight, and they will not rise again overnight, but the future looks better than it has in years. The Scottish Rite is moving into the future and using the newest technology to do it. Never forget, however, that human to human contact is still the greatest gift in Freemasonry. How you present yourself and the Organization to others is the basis of what Freemasonry is all about. Remember it takes years to get new members and to build an Organization but only minutes to lose them both. Try to use your voice to build, not to tear down, the Organization. We are ALL Master Masons and should ALL be working together for the future. Not everything works to YOUR advantage, but it may just work out to everyone else's. Sometimes selfishness, overtakes selflessness. I remember taking an oath to serve my Brethren, but I do not remember taking an oath to be served by them.

Some people say, "Hey, wait a minute you are not mentioning the York Rite," well my Brethren, the last time I checked, the <u>Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania is York.</u> Your first three degrees are York degrees, <u>Entered Apprentice Mason, Fellowcraft Mason, & Master Mason,</u> then if you choose to, you can follow through with the rest of the degrees after you join the York Rite Bodies, the <u>Chapter of Royal Arch Masons</u>, the <u>Council of Royal & Select Master Masons</u>, and the Commandery of Knights Templar.
